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Farm House Gamleveien

This building replaces an old derelict barn comprised of a courtyard, together with the existing main building. It now accommodates a small apartment, sauna/fitness room and a double garage with storage space. The three, pitched roofs represent a new interpretation of the old saddle roof and provide extra, useful space on the upper level. The two gable-pitches face the magnificent view towards the west horizon. The middle east-oriented pitch opens up towards a steep hillside nearby and gives additional daylight to the rooms on ground level. A flybridge connects the upper level for easy access to storage space on the upper level, heat pump and highly insulated construction contribute to energy efficiency.

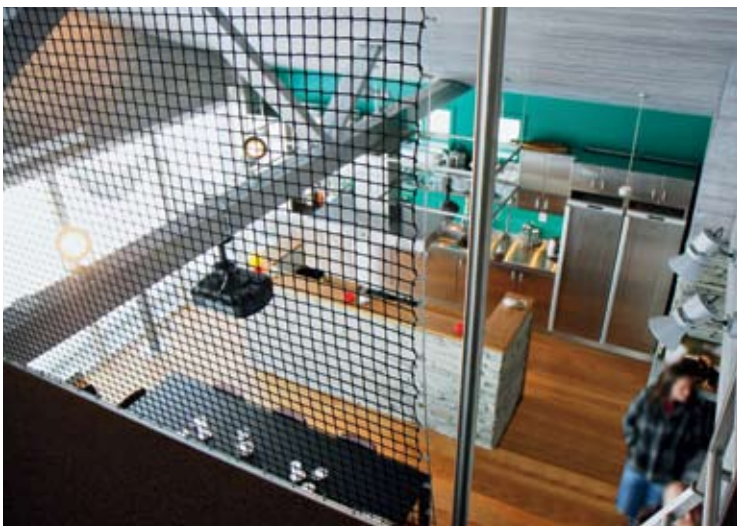
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Parisholmen Cottage

This planned summer cottage spans across a gap between the rocks. The design presents a sequence of levels, leading up to the viewpoint overlooking the fjord and open sea in the east. The green roofscape emphasizes the shape of the terrain and creates a dynamic interior which corresponds to the different levels. In conjunction with the sides of the rocks, the positioning of the building forms a natural atrium, providing room for private space and a swimming pool. The façade is clad with untreated hardwood pine and the sedum-moss roof covering blends in with the surroundings.

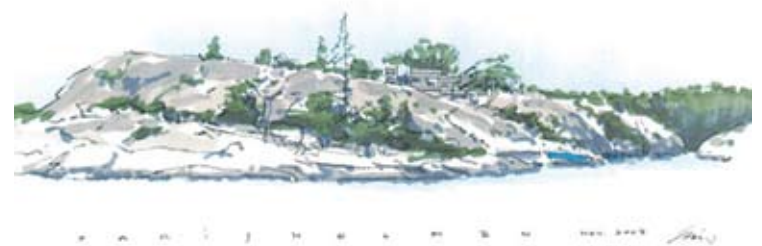

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Buholmen Cottage

This cottage replaces an old shed. It is twofold, with one residential zone and one bedroom area, and a wind-protected patio between the two. A new outhouse and pier were also part of the project. The situation forms an open wing plan, which opens towards the south. The south wing contains the private zone with compact sleeping cabins. The east wing consists of one large open living room/kitchen area, divided by a split-level, emphasizing the view towards Jomfruland. The dynamic form, with its wedge-shaped plan and tilted roofs, embraces the view to the bay in front of the cottage. The pine façade is treated with iron-sulfate which, together with the sedum-moss roof, captures the colors of the environment.
